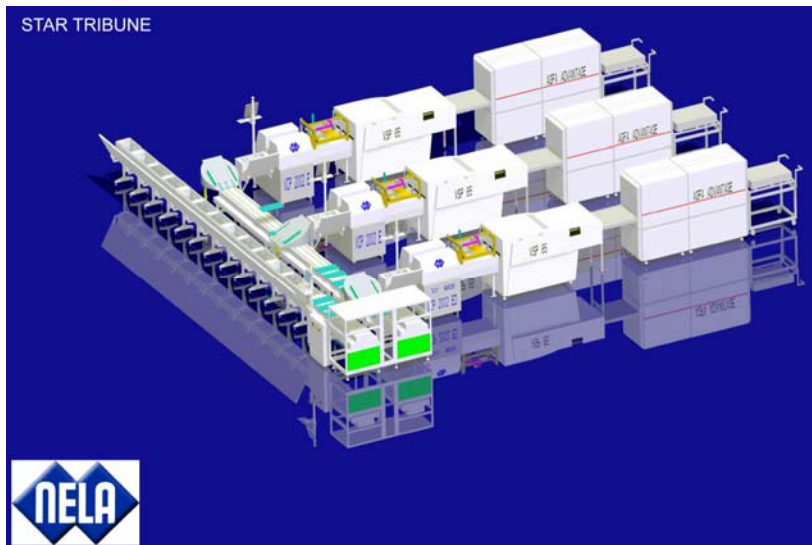




NELA scores hometown paper

Oakdale, MN – May 2, 2008 – NELA is proud to announce the partnership with its hometown paper Minneapolis Star Tribune in their prepress project.

The Minneapolis Star Tribune is adding full automation to its plateroom with the purchase of two (2) additional NELA VCP Vision PunchBenders and a 26-stations fully automated Sortation system. NELA's sortation will provide flexible plate sorting for Star Tribune's five (5) presses based on barcode information and the Star Tribune's sorting criteria. The automated plateroom solution will include NELA's Status Center which allows central point monitoring of each NELA device. The NELA automated plate room system will be integrated with three (3) lines of Agfa Advantage CTP devices and an existing NELA Vision PunchBender. This installation will provide the Star Tribune over 600 plates per hour capacity.
